Proposals for individual papers should include: name, affiliation and contact details (email address), title of paper and abstract of max 250 words. Individual papers will be assigned to panels by the organising committee.

Abstracts for panels and individual papers should be submitted by 18th April 2017 to: bacs2017@glasgow.ac.uk.

Panels and papers will be selected by the organising committee, and notification of acceptance will be made by 30 May 2017.
